
RAMONA MIDDLE SCHOOL DRIVE-THRU REGISTRATION



This year's school registration will take place in 'drive-thru' format to allow for maximum social distancing and ensure the safety and health of everyone involved. Thanks, in advance, for making this accommodation. We look forward to a quick and easy process. Everything you need to know is on this flyer.

Registration will take place over 3 days in August. The schedule is below:

8 th Grade Registration	7 th Grade Registration	6 th Grade Registration
Thursday, August 13th	Monday, August 17 th	Tuesday, August 18th

Each day, students will arrive according to a schedule based on their last name. Please do your best to arrive within the first 15 minutes of your assigned window. This will help avoid longer lines and keep things moving. Please do not arrive before your assigned time. The schedule for arriving is as follows:

Before coming to drive-thru registration, please complete your InfoSnap Registration online.

The InfoSnap information you need was included in this mailer.

Once arriving on campus, we will take your student(s) name (s) and check to make sure their InfoSnap is complete. If so, you will then be asked if you need to purchase anything from the student store (PE clothes, spirit wear, ASB Card, etc). This year, we are not going to sell Yearbooks at the beginning of the year. The cost of the yearbook may adjust as the book may change in size based on whether or not students and staff can return to campus. Yearbook sales will occur later in the year. Please access our RMS Student Store online at https://rmsvikingstore.myschoolcentral.com/ to complete any purchases before arriving.

If Infosnap and purchases are complete, you will progress through the remainder of the drive-thru registration. Here are the details for each station:

IMMUNIZATION TURN IN – All 7^{th} grade students enrolling in California public schools must have proof of immunizations with the appropriate updates. If you haven't already submitted this paperwork, you will turn it in here. Immunization records will be required for all new students entering Ramona. If not in 7^{th} grade, these records generally come from the prior school of attendance.

SCHEDULE PICK-UP – Students will receive their class schedules at this station. Schedules may be withheld for students without proper immunization records, outstanding fees owed to the school, or students without completed InfoSnap Registration.

CHROMEBOOK PICK-UP – This year, all students will be provided a Chromebook to use for school work. The public health department has asked technology not be shared among students, whenever feasible. Fortunately, we have enough devices in BUSD to provide a device to every student. A parent can decline taking a Chromebook, but students will need to have access from home to online curriculum. Later this year, when students return to campus, they will be expected to have a device to carry with them between classes. It is recommended that all students receive a BUSD Chromebook.

TEXTBOOK TURN-IN/PICK-UP – If a student has textbooks or library books from last year that were not turned in already, they may do so at this station. This station will pass out textbooks for this year for use by students. All students will receive a history book. Some students will receive a Math or English book, based on which course they are enrolled in. Science is done online and will not have a textbook this year. PE and Electives will not have a text book.
